


Did you know...

In 2019:

- Manitoba artists released over 172 singles/albums
- Manitoba artists won 39 music awards and were nominated for 192 awards, including JUNO Awards, WCMAs, Indigenous Music Awards, and more!
- Manitoba artists had over 220 international mentions in the media
 - over 4,000 artist entrepreneurs
 - over 600 freelance professionals
 - over 170 music businesses
 - Is an industry worth over \$112 million

Music Industry Jobs

Artist Manager: directs artist's career

Record Producer: records and arranges music

Audio Engineer: captures studio or live sound

Booking Agent: books shows and tours

Record Label: markets recordings

Publicist: gets the artist media attention

Promoter/ Booker/ Talent Buyer: puts on concerts

Tour Manager: handles all road logistics

Publisher: finds uses for songs

Music Supervisor: pitches songs for TV, films, ads,

video games
